3	Nasu Plant (Nasu-cho, Tochigi Prefecture)	- These factories and facilities are located in areas of scheduled power outages by Tokyo Electric Power Co. (TEPCO) Operating hours are being revised accordingly and with intent to minimize the affect on production and shipments. - The impact of the earthquake and tsunami disaster and the nuclear plant crisis on parts and material supply is being evaluated.
4	Yaita Plant (Yaita-shi, Tochigi Prefecture)	
5	Sano Plant (Sano-shi, Tochigi Prefecture)	
6	Tanuma Plant (Sano-shi, Tochigi Prefecture)	
7	Hanno Plant (Hanno-shi, Saitama Prefecture)	
8	Shizuoka Sales Office (Numazu City, Shizuoka Prefecture)	- This office is located in the area (Group 3) affected by TEPCO's rolling power outage. - Although operations at this office will continue during this blackout, telephone, fax, and electronic mail communications will be halted.
9	Other sales offices and facilities	- Normal hours
